Dr. Avis Glaze has served as Ontario's Education Commissioner and Senior Adviser to the Minister of Education. She was the first Chief Student Achievement Officer of Ontario and founding CEO of the Ministry of Education's Literacy and Numeracy Secretariat. Working collaboratively with educators, she played a pivotal role in the student achievement gains in Ontario. Under her leadership, the Secretariat won the Amethyst Award for outstanding contribution in the Ontario Public Service.

In evaluating the Secretariat, the Canadian Language and Literacy Network (CLLRNet, 2007) described her as one of Ontario's most influential educators. Dr. Glaze has worked in several school districts, both rural and urban, public and catholic. She has worked at all levels in Ontario's school system and has served as a superintendent and director of education. A prolific author and international speaker, Avis knows firsthand education systems across the globe.

Dr. Glaze was sent to South Africa by the Canadian government to assist with education reform and national reconstruction. She has been a classroom teacher, special education teacher, guidance counsellor, secondary administrator and teacher educator in faculties of education. She pioneered the implementation of character development in school districts in Ontario and was later asked to implement this initiative provincially.

She has extensive experience in leadership development and coaching and in making organizations more effective in delivering on their mission. She has been a tireless advocate for equity of outcomes for all students, has received honourary doctorates from several Canadian universities, and won numerous awards for her international contributions to education, including the prestigious Order of Ontario.
